MISSION

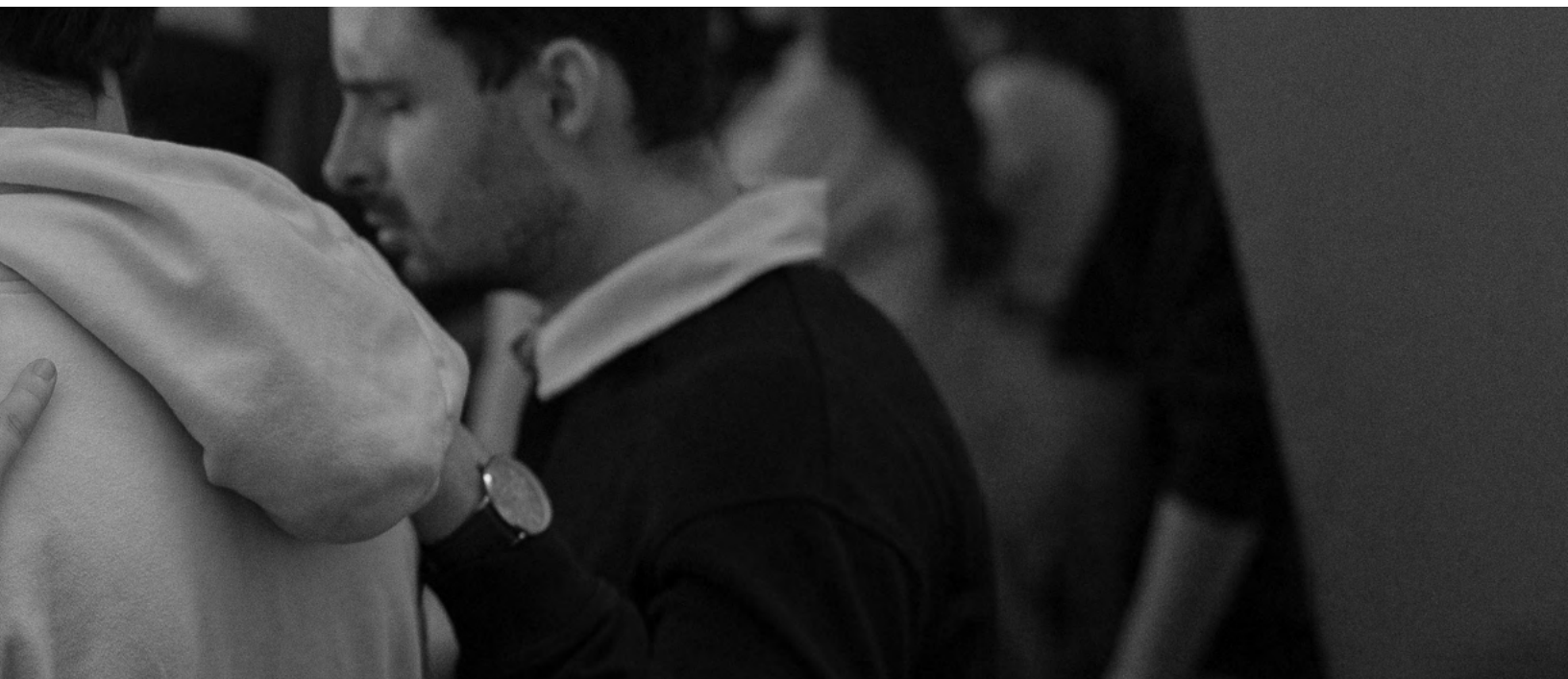
To partner with the Holy Spirit in the renewal of the local church by forming a creative leadership movement marked by excellence, character, and the presence of Jesus.

THE PROGRAM

All students will participate in one six-week spiritual formation course, followed by a six-week Bible and theology course. The initial course is designed to cover core aspects of spiritual formation, while the Bible course is designed to support theological and biblical revelation and application. Together, both serve to ultimately create practical growth and training in the student's leadership and missional action, while simultaneously strengthening devotion to Jesus.

Bible and Theology:

The core of the TMS experience is growth in knowledge and understanding of the Bible. We believe that all spiritual formation and leadership must ultimately be based off of a deep love and understanding of the Scriptures. To that end, our school is structured to catalyze students encounter with God through the Bible.

Spiritual Formation:

All students will participate in formation classes related to Jesus, spiritual disciplines, experience, and identity. The goal is to learn how to follow Jesus well in every day life, and the fruit will be a lifestyle of renewal.

Leadership:

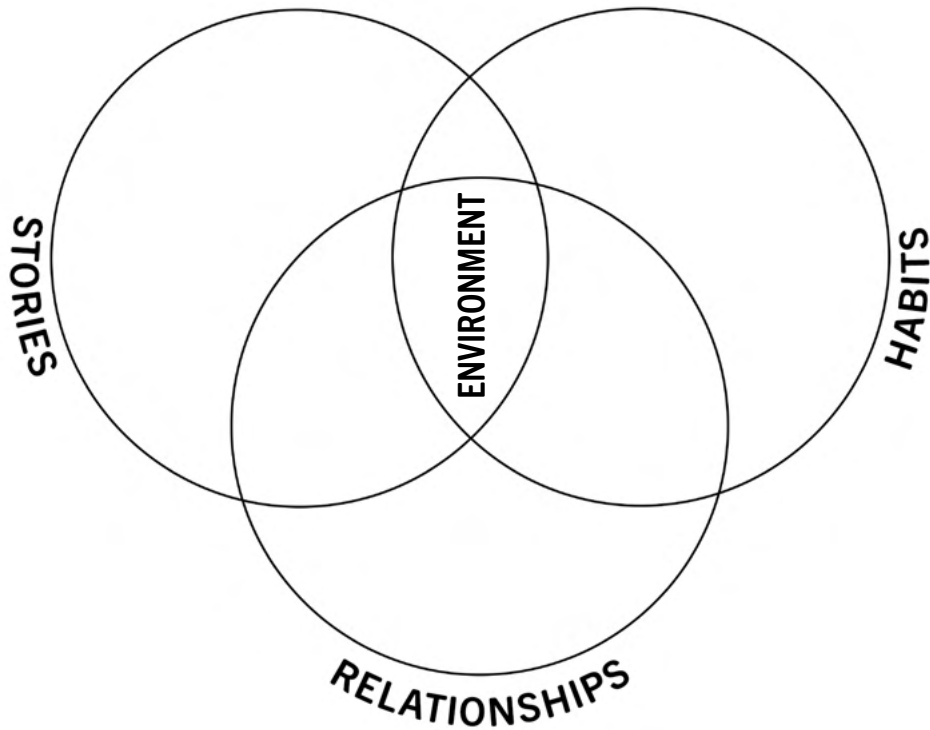

Missional Action:

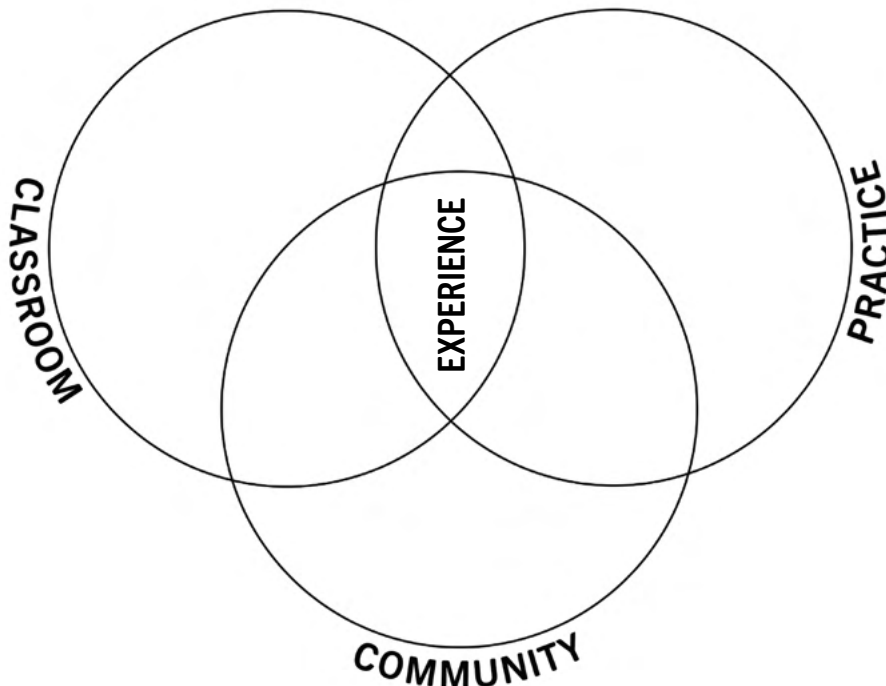

THE WAYS

Class – Tuesday

Class is a time of conceptual expansion and supernatural impartation. You will participate in weekly classes that are dynamic and designed to both inspire and educate. This is the core of our community, and mandatory for all students to attend.

Shared Practices – Rule of Life

Psychological research suggests that somewhere between five and sixty percent of our daily activity is the product of conscious, intentional 'choice,' while our remaining daily activity takes place via habit/automation. In other words, humans are creatures of habits, and unless we challenge and change our base functions (habits), we will struggle to flourish into our God given identity, purpose, and calling.

This means that if we want to be participate in intentional spiritual formation, we must challenge our rhythms and habits. All Tehillah Ministry School students will participate in a shared rule of life that challenges them to move toward discipline and awareness. The rule of life consists of shared rhythms related to bible reading and memorization, prayer, fasting, screen time, sabbath, mentorship, etc.

Internships

Critical to our spiritual formation is voluntarily giving and receiving from others. Students will intern with leaders who they consider to be role models in their life. All students must have an internship. Internships are expected to take place within each student's local church context. These internships provide space to grow in our areas of learning.

WE LEARN

Experience

Each evening ends with Ministry Time where students are provided space to encounter and experience Holy Spirit, grow in spiritual gifting, and participate in practical ministry.

As well, students will be given opportunities to lead at Tehillah through prayer and prophetic ministry.

Spiritual Direction

All students are provided one spiritual direction sessions included within tuition. The session are provides opportunity to frame the school year in order to help process growth and transformation.

Mentorship

All students will meet once a month with their mentorship cohorts to discuss key concepts, ministry issues, and personal aspects of their lives. These mentorship groups are mandatory, because they provide opportunity for processing within a facilitated group setting. These mentorship cohorts will be facilitated by the Tehillah Ministry School Leaders.

Internship:

2 hours/week at your own convenience

Rule of Life:

Spiritual disciplines integrated into your daily routine, for a total of 45 minutes - 1 hour per day (or more if you want!)

Assignments:

2-3 times monthly

Required:

At the core of TMS is a community of people who are passionate about following Jesus and learning together. During your time here, you will form friendships that last a lifetime. We care deeply about fostering a sense of community that is committed to growing together. Because we are not a full time program, we ask that you prioritize the times we have designed. To that end, **we require all students to make a minimum commitment of 2 full semesters.** There are no exceptions to this rule. More than the personal growth, it has been the life-long friendships that have been formed through this community that are the greatest fruit.
